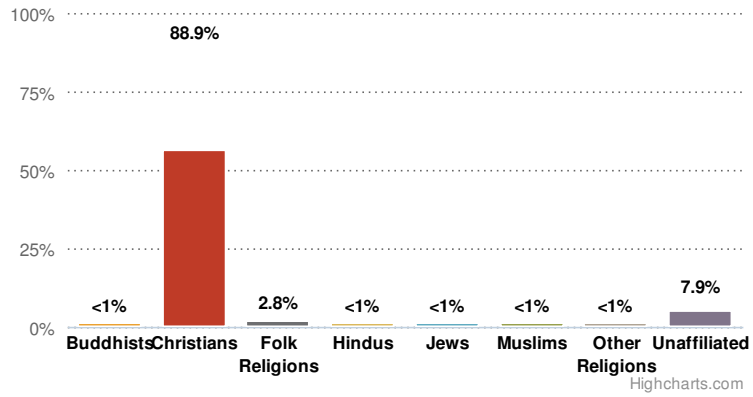

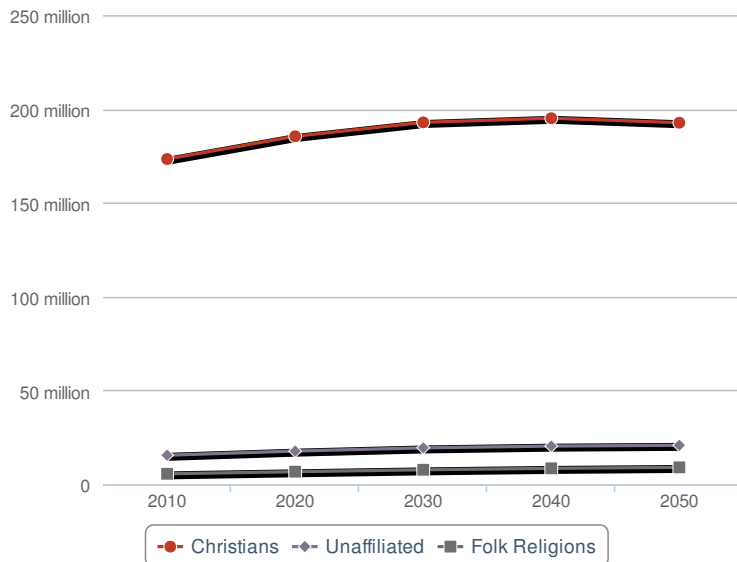

**Religious Affiliation (2010 - All Religious Groups)**



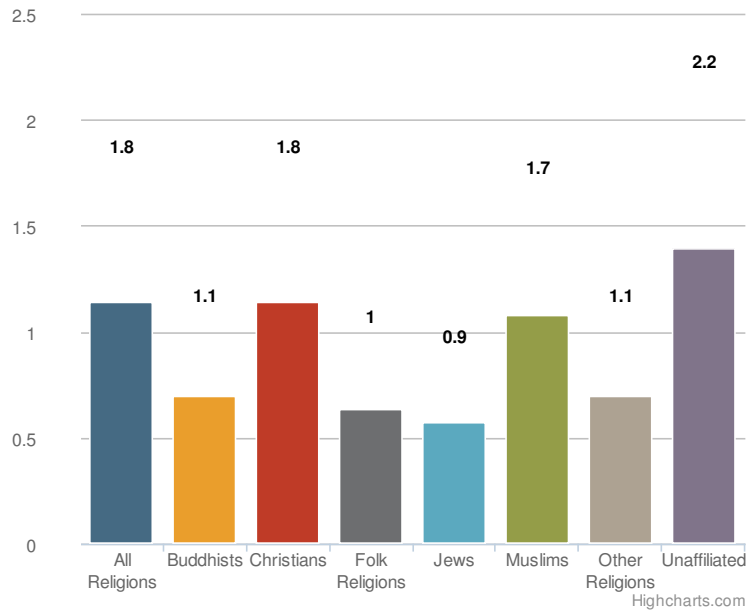
**Religious Affiliation Over Time**

Folk Religions, Christians, Unaffiliated



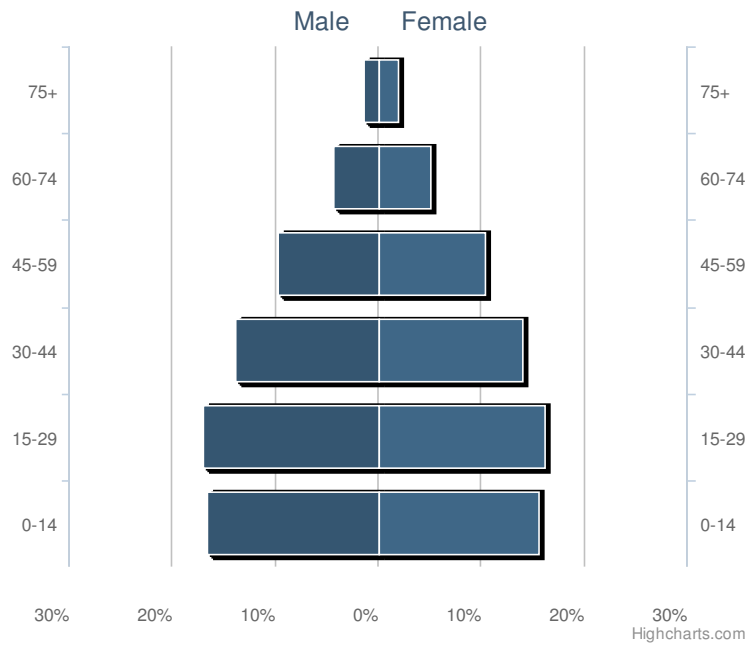

### Fertility Rate (TFR) (2010-2015)



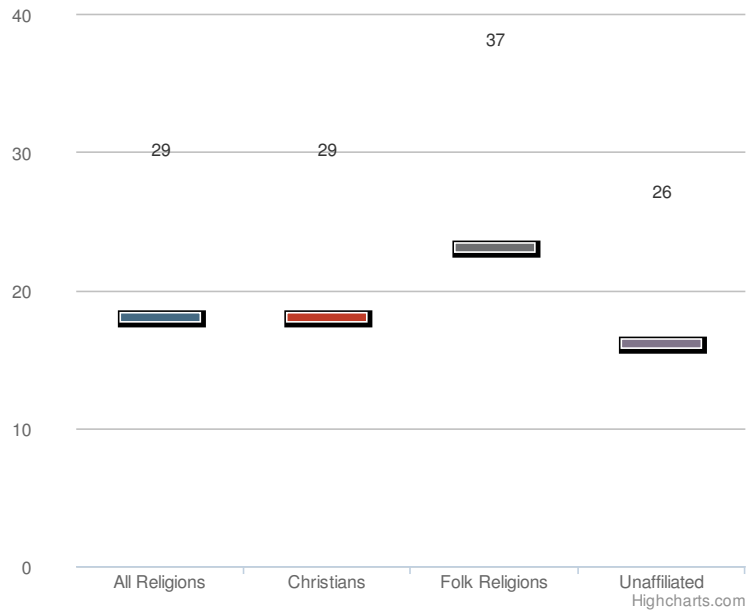
