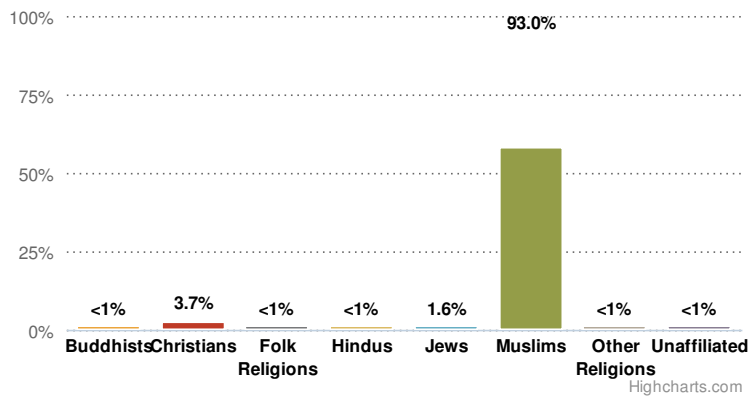

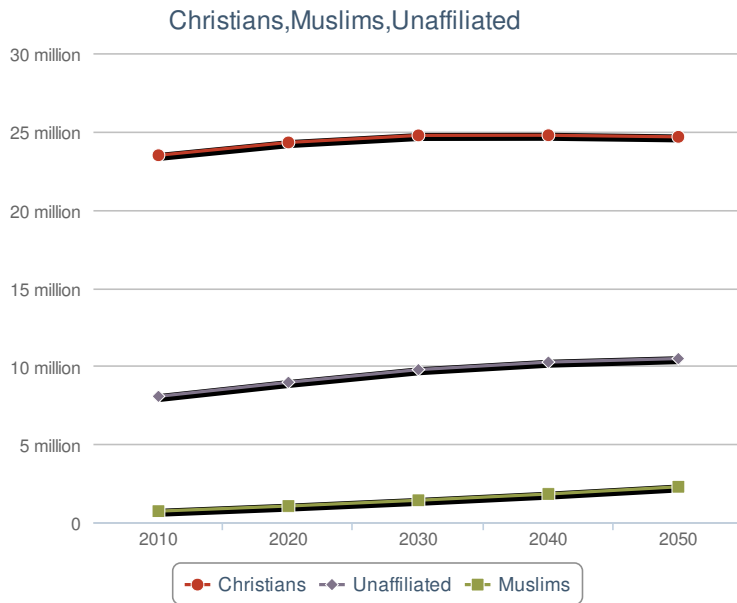

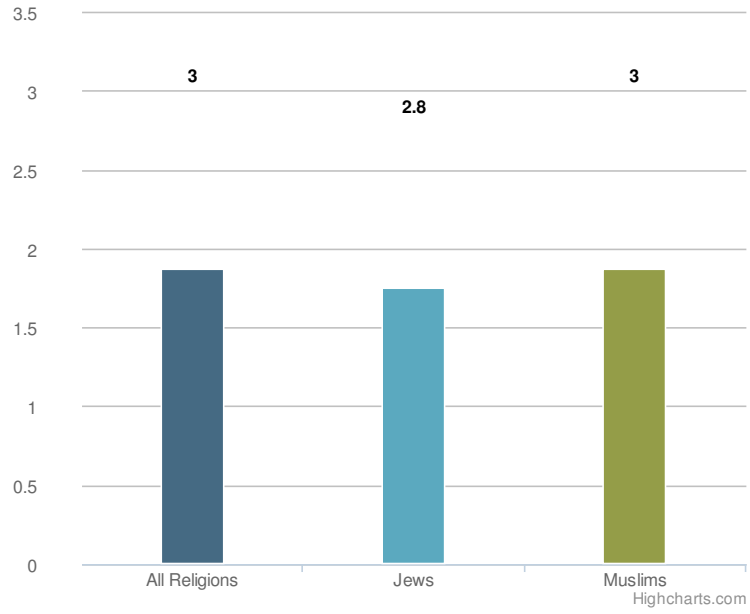


Religious Affiliation Over Time

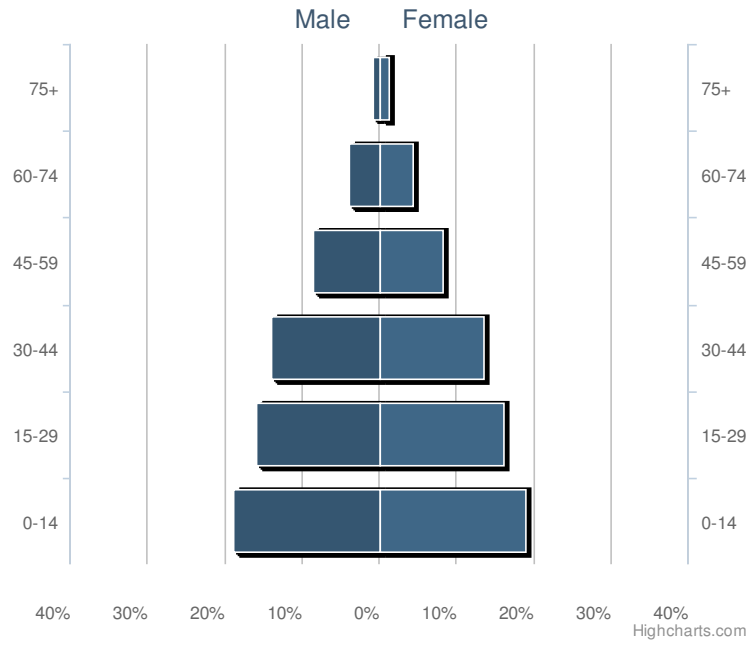

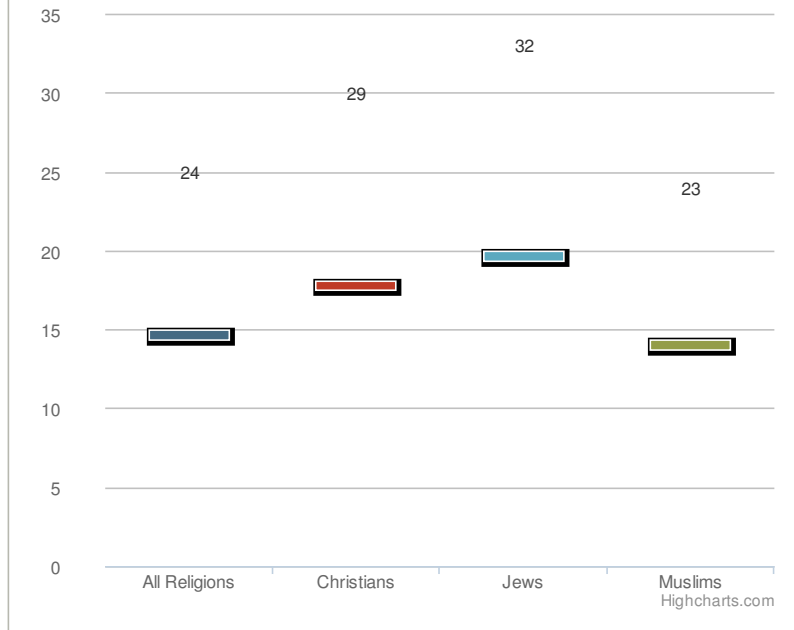
Fertility Rate
